# Building And Grounds Committee Report



There has been a lot of discussion over the needs for a new multi purpose building at the club. With this and other looming possibilities for grants, we have hired L. Robert Kimball and associates of Ebensburg, PA

to complete a civil survey package that will include: aerial photography, contour mapping development, along with the creation of a site plan that will be beneficial to the club in planning any future site improvements and aid in grant funding. There are many options for a new building, and a variety of needs the building would need to cover. With this in mind, the process of evaluating the needs for a new building will take some time. The type, location, size, and design of the building

is being discussed currently by the Development Committee, a list of suggestions will be presented to the membership in the following months coming up. The membership is considering purchasing and replacing the front steel entrance door to the clubhouse. The old door is worn out and needs replaced.
